Class 1 – Miss Batachelov and Mrs Lovett:

We enjoyed the story of the 'Little Red Hen's Pizza' and we have had fun working on lots of related activities – did you taste our yummy pizza?! We also read 'Pedro's Pancakes' and we made instructions for making pancakes and played a pancake spinner game. We have really enjoyed giving the bee-bob direction instructions to move them around a food trail.

- Literacy – Year 1 – Recognise the role of repeated phrases in fairy tales, identify and compare characters. Reception – show an understanding of the main elements or stories.
- Numeracy – Reception – develop mathematic ideas and methods to solve practical problems relating to buying food in the café. Year 1 – Compare two or more weights by direct comparison.



Class 2 – Mrs Stepney:

This week we have been finding out about the features of reports in preparation for writing our own reports next week. In numeracy Yr2's are learning how to add by partitioning numbers and to subtract by counting on. The Yr1's are partitioning numbers into tens and units and have been ordering numbers. In PE we have started our unit on rocking and rolling and have been experimenting with different ways to roll our bodies.

- Literacy – to read and recognise the features of a report.
- Numeracy – Yr2 – to add numbers by partitioning. To find the difference by counting on. Yr1 – to partition numbers into tens and units. To order numbers.

Class 3 – Miss Wernham:

We have had a lot of fun learning about and performing rap poems in Literacy. Bet all the Dad's and Gran's didn't know they could rap!?!? In DT we practiced making nets for our containers, with mixed success! Whilst in PE we did some time travelling and exploration as part of our Egyptian dance.

- Literacy – to perform a rap poem in class. To write own rap poems.
- Numeracy – to use practical written methods to multiply and divide 2 digit numbers.

- Maths: to divide using a number line.
- Literacy: to write an Indian story.



Class 5 – Miss Herbert:

In maths we have been revising the mode, mean, median and range. In literacy we have been doing hybrid texts. In science we've been learning about using evaporation to filter water. In PE with Mr Clements we have been learning basket ball. In DT we have been looking at slippers and how they are designed.
